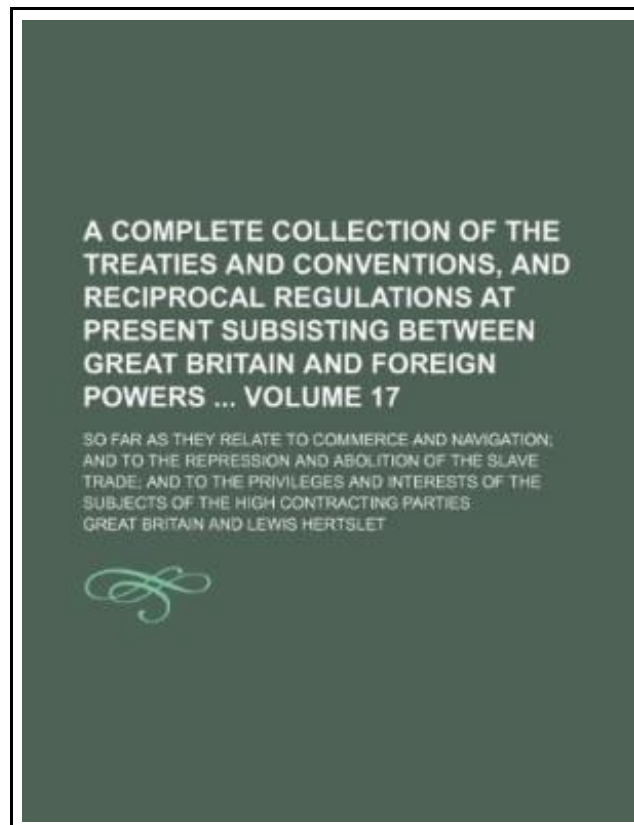

Not illustrated. 1890 Excerpt: .therein, shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable upon conviction to pay--For the first offence any sum not exceeding 5 pesetas for every day on which he shall have remained improperly in Gibraltar, and in default of payment to imprisonment in the civil prison with or without hard labour for any period not exceeding 24 hours. For the second offence any sum not exceeding 10 pesetas per diem and in default of payment to imprisonment with or without hard labour for any period not exceeding 4 days. For the third and every subsequent offence any sum not exceeding 20 pesetas per diem and in default of payment to imprisonment with or without hard labour for any period not exceeding 6 months. 29.
