It is in accordance with our English and Irish ideas on the subject; for it aims at teaching the horse manners, and giving him a snaffle-bridle mouth; so that he will go up to the bridle, and bend himself in thorough obedience to rein and leg. As a personal explanation, I may mention that after having spent many years racing and training in India, during which time I practised the ordinary methods of breaking, I returned to England, where I learned the use of the standing martingale and long driving reins, as applied specially to jumpers, from Mr. John Hubert Moore, who was the cleverest maker of steeplechasers...
