Past studies showed that inhaling diesel exhaust particles in combination with an allergen could make a person much more sensitive to that allergen by activating the persons immune system in a process called adjuvancy. However, although adjuvancy could increase asthma prevalence in the long term, scientists observed asthma are-ups only hours or minutes after exposure to high concentrations of particles. The University of California, Los Angeles, researchers set out to establish the biological basis for this immediate effect. The researchers faced the challenge of making a mouses lungs highly sensitive to pollutants so that they would resemble the lungs of people with asthma, prone to swelling that narrows the airways.
